Water Technology was commissioned by Goulburn Broken CMA to develop a Waterway Health Activity Plan (WHAP) for the Shepparton-Maroopna area, encompassing the riparian zones of the Broken and Goulburn Rivers. The WHAP's purpose was twofold; to guide the implementation of river management works in the project area and to become a key reference document for the development of a Master Plan for the Shepparton urban area.

Key objectives for this project involved:

- Identifying values and threats to those values with the project area
- Establishing management zones that allow for effective value/threat management across the varying land tenures and land managers
- Recommends actions to reduce identified threats to values and protect and enhance existing values
- Provides actions that are specific, achievable, costed and prioritised.
